A typical day during the week of Band Camp will look like this

9am - Visual rehearsal in stadium (marching, drill, etc.)

1pm - 90-minute Lunch break and activities

2:30pm - Sectional rehearsal indoors (stay inside during hottest part of day, work on music)

5:30pm - 1-hour Dinner break

6:30pm - Ensemble rehearsal in stadium (all sections on field, put the show together) 9:00pm - Done

Parents are invited to watch rehearsals, help out with activities, etc.

SCARLET KNIGHTS MARCHING BAND UNIFORM CARE

All members of the NAHS band will be issued a marching band uniform. This includes a jacket, bib pants, cape, shakos, neck liner, hanger, and garment bag. A white polo shirt with band logo is also required for warm weather events such as parades. Uniform care and maintenance are the responsibilities of the student for the entire year. The uniforms are particularly expensive and should be treated with extreme care.

- Always hang uniforms. Fold pants neatly to avoid ironing!
- Pants should be wrinkle free and creased. Length should be to top of shoe. Iron when needed.
- IF the uniform gets damp, hang it to dry. It is wool and easily damaged if allowed to stay wet. Never keep a wet uniform in a zipped uniform bag – you won't like the smell next time you open the bag!
- Uniform bag should be treated with care. Spraying the bag with *febreze* periodically is recommended.
- If you need to dry clean your uniform during the school year, take to Kim's dry-cleaners only.
- Students are responsible for wearing BLACK socks with uniform. Leave extra socks in your bag, just in case you need them.
- Students will be issued one pair of black gloves at the first football game. Lost gloves will be replaced at a cost of \$4.00.
- Black *dinkle* shoes must be worn with uniforms. These may be purchased through NAMA. Dinkles have soles that are specially cut for marching.
- Uniforms will be distributed during Band Camp week. A \$20.00 fee (used for end-of-year drying cleaning) must be paid **before** uniform is taken. If uniform changes are needed during the year (size, damage, etc), contact a NAMA board member.
- Uniform includes white polo shirt with band logo – must be kept clean and worn in warm weather events such as parades. One time purchase for all years of band involvement \$24.00

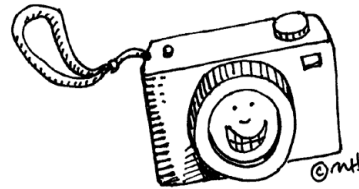


Photo/Videography Consent Form
